ADULT/YOUTH STAFF FOOD/HEAT MONEY: Actual cost will be determined after shopping and will be collected during the camping trip. Cost averages around \$15 (Please bring singles).

ADULT NON-DRIVER TRANSPORTATION: \$ 14.00 to be paid to the **Troop** by March 12th (exact change please)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- All Scouts whose parent/guardian is not driving **MUST** pay the transportation fee to the troop. It will be distributed among the drivers that drive Scouts other than their own and/or troop equipment. Please do not pay a driver directly. Non driving adults need to pay this fee as well.
- Every driver must have a valid driver's license, insurance coverage, and adhere to BSA driving policy.
- When possible the Troop will have the trailer available for Troop equipment and Scout backpacks.
- To minimize driving, parents providing transportation that wish to stay with the Troop are welcome.
