Congratulations on your election as a candidate for the Order of the Arrow, Scouting's National Honor Society! The Order recognizes campers who best exemplify the Scout Oath and Law in their daily lives. Your next step to become a member of Na Tsi Hi Lodge is to attend one of our Powwows, which are scheduled as follows:

Spring Powwow (Forestburg): June 3- 5, 2016

Fall Powwow (Quail Hill – bring a tent): Sep 9-11, 2016

Registration due June 1st

Registration due Sept. 7th

You **must** attend one of these weekends to become a member of Na Tsi Hi Lodge. If you miss both weekends, your troop will have to elect you again in a subsequent year.

ADVANCED REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED – PLEASE READ

The Powwow/induction fee is \$35. If you plan to attend a Powwow, the fee is due no later than the indicated registration due date (above.) The induction fee pays for your meals, OA sash, OA Handbook, lodge flap patch, and OA registration. Make checks payable to Monmouth Council, BSA.

If you missed the deadline, but still want to attend, you will be charged an additional \$10 fee (for a total of \$45) AND you must call the Council Service Center before 5:00 pm Thursday to notify them that you will be attending. Bring your registration form, medical form and payment of \$45 to check-in on Friday evening of the Powwow. If you register for a Powwow and cannot attend, please notify Council Service Center before that weekend,, that you will be missing the Powwow and to transfer your registration to the later Powwow. You must complete your ordeal in the same year elected, and cannot carry your induction over to the following year.

You must arrive between 6:00pm and 8:00pm on Friday night. The induction program starts promptly on Friday with a ceremony that all candidates must attend. The Powwow will end Sunday between 11:00am and 12:00pm.

Late arrivals or early departures are not permitted.

Eat dinner before arriving, as no meal will be served Friday evening. Arrive dressed in work clothing - you will be performing camp service projects for the first part of the weekend.

Mandatory items to bring:

- A pack containing your regular camping gear, which must include a full Class-A Scout uniform, watch, flashlight, towel and toiletries, sleeping pad, any electronic devices, etc. Also bring a tent for the Spring and Fall Powwows at Quail Hill. (You will not need a tent at Summer PowWow- Forestburg)
- **In a bag separate from your pack:** ground cloth, sleeping bag, small pillow, raingear, work gloves, pocket knife, and any prescription or OTC (over the counter) medications. No electronic devices.
- Include BSA Part A & C Medical forms with your registration. Forms can be downloaded from the BSA website: www.scouting.org. Medical forms are required for all youth and adults (please follow the instructions on the form). Your Medical form can be returned at the end of the weekend. Note any allergies on your medical form. All prescription or non-prescription medications being taken **must** be noted on the Medical form. Bring medication with you in their original containers – do not repackage medications.
