Personal equipment check list for summer camp

- Scout Uniform
 - Scout Shirt, Scout Shorts, Scout Belt, Green Scout Socks (above the ankle)
- Pajamas or other sleeping clothes
- Swimming trunks (2 pair). Pack one in a daypack with a towel for Saturday/Sunday swim check
- Regular socks: 7 day supply
- T-shirts and shorts: 7 day supply
- Long pants for cold nights (or sweatpants)
- Underwear: 7 day supply
- 2-3 towels: At least 1 for lake and 1 for shower.
- Wash cloths
- Poncho or Rain gear
- Lightweight jacket or sweatshirt for cool nights and mornings.
- Baseball hat to keep the sun out of your eyes.
- Long pants if taking climbing, wilderness survival, camping, hiking, biking.
- Long pants and long sleeve button down shirt if taking swimming/lifesaving (will go in the lake).
- Work gloves (in a day pack for Saturday)
- Sneakers and hiking shoes/boots in case it gets muddy
- Spending money (a few dollars a day for candy/slushies/etc) if desired.
- Water shoes or an old pair of sneakers for the canoe trip. (sneakers will be ruined)
- Shower shoes / flipflops for shower
- Sleeping bag or bed sheets / blankets or both.
- Air mattress or sleeping bag pad (for on top of cot)
- Hanger and garment bag for uniform
- Toiletry kit (soap in a soap container, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb or brush, metal mirror, nail clippers, tissues, deodorant, shampoo, baby powder, contact lens case/cleaner, dental floss, etc– no aerosol cans)
- Insect repellent (No aerosol cans) (Show your scout how to apply it)
- Sun Screen (Show your scout how to apply it)
- Sharp Scout knife for woodcarving merit badge
- Scout handbook to work on advancement to 1st class.
- OA sash (for OA members)
- Pencils, Pens, notebooks (for MB classes)
- Flashlight with new batteries, extra batteries, extra flashlight
- Personal first aid kit (bandaids, etc)
- Laundry bag
- Day pack to carry MB class materials.
- Refillable water bottle.
- Mosquito net
- Camp chair
- Hard case for eye glasses
- Lantern (1 per tent)
- Clothes line(1 per tent) and clothes pins (bring extra, they walk)
- Extra clothing
- **Optional:** Inexpensive camera, throw rug, pillow, compass (if orienteering), fishing gear (if fishing), drinking cup, inexpensive sun glasses
- **LEAVE AT HOME:** Merit badge sash, troop neckerchief, troop hat, pins, medals, camping patches, ax, den chief cords, sheath or survival knives, electronics, coolers, cell phones.
- **SPACE IS LIMITED.** If it doesn't fit in your trunk, on or under your bunk, leave it home.
- **SEE THE NOTE IN THE BOX ON THIS PAGE.** EVERYTHING means EVERY THING he brings.
- **Common Sense:** If you need it, and it's not on this list, bring it.
