Camp Fee:.....\$355

Canoe Trip (optional, but recommended):.....\$28

Saturday, July 9th campers: (for those willing to work for the day)\$8
(The additional \$8 is to help cover the cost of dinner on Saturday and Breakfast and Lunch on Sunday)

Merit Badge Class Fees:

Supplies for Basketry, Leatherwork & Wood Carving.....\$25-30

Supplies for Space Exploration (Rocket kit).....\$10

All merit badge craft kits can be purchased at camp on Sunday.

Snacks and Souvenirs (Optional, but recommended):.....\$1-\$50

- Give them as much as you want to allow them to spend, because they will spend every dime you give them. Candy, soda, juice, hot pockets, crackers, cookies, white castle hamburgers, slushies, etc., are available during the week. Slushies are \$1.00 and worth every penny on a hot day!!!
- Due to animal feeding concerns, food and sweet drinks are not allowed in the campsite. Do not send snacks from home. All snacks are to be consumed in the camp program areas after purchase from the Trading Post.
- Meals and drinks are included in the camp fee and water is readily available, but that does not stop the scouts from snacking once in a while.
- The camp also sells T-shirts, sweat shirts and other "Keowa" logo items.
- Recommendation: \$4 per day, plus \$15 for souvenirs.
- Adults can not "loan" scouts money. If they do not bring it, we assume you did not want them to spend it.
- Adults do not "hold" Scouts money. Each Scout is to keep his own money locked securely in his trunk.
